

A week in a Holiday Home in Amble, Northumberland.

Local properties like this let for several hundred pounds per week



3 Bay View, Amble NE65 0AZ

The house is built right on the harbour in Amble, a pretty small port in Northumberland. The picture isn't faked, seaspray hits the windows.

The essentials

Beds for six in three rooms, parking for two cars.

The house looks out over the sea and the harbour, looking northwest.

Upstairs there are three bedrooms, one double, a king size/ 2 twins and a room with un bunked bunks. There is an ensuite toilet and shower, and a separate bathroom. One of the doubles overlooks the harbour and has floor to ceiling folding windows and a Juliet balcony, so if you want some peace and quiet and a view, it is delightful. There are two hanging racks for clothes and a hanging system for underwear.

Downstairs there is one large room with the kitchen, dining area and lounge. This room also has patio doors the full width of the lounge overlooking the sea and harbour. The kitchen is fully equipped with a microwave, dishwasher, fridge freezer and washing machine. There is a downstairs toilet and a storage space.

There is a small patio overlooking the harbour and private parking for two cars behind the house.

In front of the house is a small shallow sandy bay, part of the harbour, with rock pools on the other side of the harbour arm. Behind the house is a public children's play area and another bay. If you are a birdwatcher it is great.

The house stands at the end of a cul de sac so there is very little traffic.

The house has wi-fi, a TV and mobile phone signal.

The town has a street of shops including two CO-OPs and a small Tesco, plenty of pubs and fish and chip shops.

You will need to bring your own sheets, pillow cases, towels and tea towels. There is selection of bedding.

We ask you to tidy when you leave, leaving it ready for the next occupants.
